

Filling the Spaces (Handout on DVD-disk)

This Longarm class goes over the basic shapes of quilting.

How those shapes are used to fill the spaces. You will learn how to proportionally fit designs in different shaped area.

How to use a semi float technique to put your quilt tops on the longarm. The video shows you how to tie off the ends of the quilting. We also go over the basics of free motion feathers and many other motifs.

You will need to make this top.

A: 8 1/2" by 8 1/2"

B: 3 1/2" by 5 1/2"

C: 3 1/2" by 3 1/2"

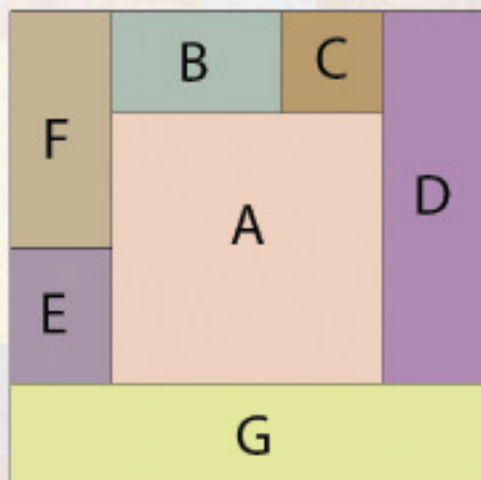
D: 3 1/2" by 11 1/2"

E: 3 1/2" by 4 1/2"

F: 3 1/2" by 7 1/2"

G: 3 1/2" by 14 1/2"

Add a 4 inch border on all sides.



Supplies:

Quilt Back measuring 24"x 24", Hobb's wool batting 24" x 24", 40wt cotton thread marking pencil, scissors, tweezers, needle to bury threads,
