

This class will teach you how to use Piec-liqu  to make a very graphic piece. This class is designed for the average quilter that wants to move onto a higher level of work. Every art quilter will love this class. If you have loved curved seams but were afraid to try them now is the time.

Supplies Needed:

Equipment needed:

Sewing machine.

You won't need your sewing machine until in the afternoon.

Quarter inch piecing foot.

A single needle plate for your sewing machine.

Size 75 machine embroidery needles.

Mettler size 50/3 cotton thread (beige or gray) for piecing.

Basic sewing Kit.

Hard pressing Mat.

Regular spray starch. (No spray sizing)

Freezer paper.

Small stencil brush (small).

Water Soluble Basting Glue

Permanent marking pen.

Surgical tweezers,

Scissors (Paper and fabric scissors).

Iron: You will need your own.

The only one that I find is hot enough to work is a Rowenta travel iron. You will need to purchase one. A must, no other iron works.

Fabrics:

24" square for outside frame

Fat quarter of 5 different yellows

12" square of 5 different turquoises for blooms

12" square of 3 different greens for leaves
