## Old Rose

This class will teach you how to use Piec-liqu  to make a very graphic piece. This class is designed for the average quilter that wants to move onto a higher level of work. Every art quilter will love this class. If you have loved curved seams but were afraid to try them now is the time.

### Supplies Needed:

Equipment needed:

Sewing machine

(You won't need your sewing machine until in the afternoon. )

Quarter inch piecing foot

A single needle plate for your sewing machine (recommended, not mandatory)

Size 75/11 machine embroidery needles

Mettler or DMC size 50/3 cotton thread (beige or gray) for piecing

Basic sewing Kit

Hard pressing Mat

Regular spray starch. (No spray sizing)

Freezer paper

Small stencil brush (3/8 in)

Water Soluble Basting Glue (NOT a glue stick)

Permanent marking pen

Surgical/Angled tweezers

Scissors (Paper and fabric scissors)

Iron: You will need your own

The only one that I find is hot enough to work is a Rowena or Black & Decker travel iron. You will need to purchase one. This is a must-no other iron works as well.

Fabrics:

Assorted fabrics:

2 fat half's of light gold for back ground. 22" by 36"

4 fat quarters of coral for the rose - 2 light colors and 2 dark

2 fat quarters of green, one just darker than the other

Use your imagination on the colors you choose; the brighter the better.
